Nominating Committee:

The Process of Electing New Officers

According to the WCC Bylaws, each January a Nominating Committee of seven (7) members is appointed. Each member at the January general meeting may complete a nomination form stating whom they wish to nominate and sign her own name and deposit the form in a box. The President then draws a nomination form from the box, announces the name and gives the nominee a chance to decline or accept. The drawing continues until seven have agreed to serve.

The President officially appoints those seven members as the Nominating Committee. The committee members select a chairman and hold meetings as they determine necessary. The Nominating Committee selects a nominee for each office and verifies that the nominee will accept and serve.

The Nominating Committee announces their choices at the March General Meeting. After the presiding officer repeats the list of nominees, she will call for nominations from the floor.

Voting takes place at the April Meeting and Installation is in May.

This year's committee consists of Co-chairs, Judy Hardegree and Diane Vitale, Kay Vider, Sharon Williams, Gail Claffey, Rowan Quave and Cheri Leistner.

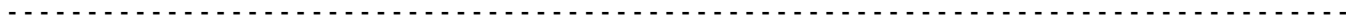
Laura Gumm

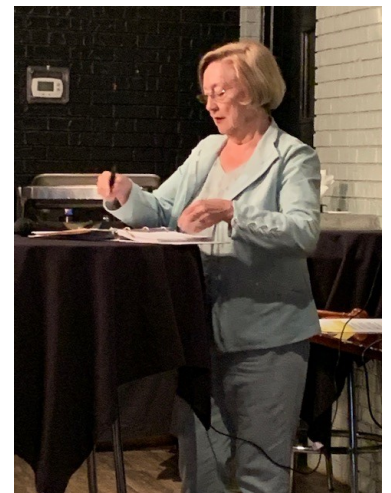
PCB Mayor Mike Thomas was the speaker for the day and he caught members up on all the latest developments of businesses, buildings and roads in the area.

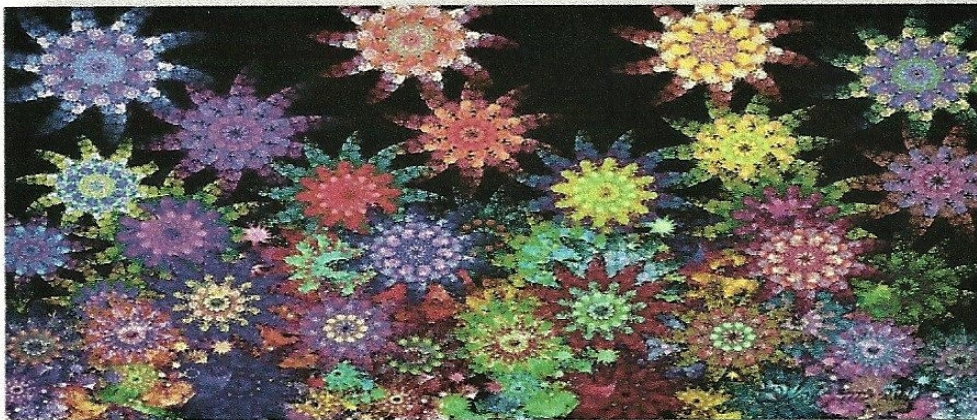
